Celery

Celery loves water and doesn't like to dry out. Grow in a shaded location. Harvest individual stems and allow the center to keep growing and harvest the entire plant just before frost. Celery preserves well in the freezer.

Bite size fruit that taste like a mild cucumber. Grown on a vine, use a tomato cage and is easy to grow. Eat fresh, on a charcuterie board or as a garnish for a drink. Pickles well.

High yielding, Large, uniform and tender spears. Cold-hardy and heat-tolerant. Harvest from early April through to mid-May. All-males plants. Self-pollinating.

A heirloom tomato with round fruit that is 15 to 20 cm and are almost black. They have a dynamic flavour. Indeterminate, matures in 65 days.

Tomato Brandywine

A heirloom tomato. Pink coloured fruit. Large fruit 1.5 lbs. Indeterminate, matures in 100 days.



Tomato Amish Paste

A heirloom that is used in sauces and pastes. Shape varies from 'ox hart' to plum. Indeterminate, matures in 70 to 75 days.

Tomato Black Krim

A heirloom that is very tasty Large fruit 0.5 lbs. Typically they range from dark purple to mahogany skin with green shoulders and green tinted flesh. Indeterminate, 80 days.

Nice tasting and is suitable for canning. 7 to 8 oz fruit. Determinate, matures in 70 days. Use a cage.



Tomato Chef's Choice Orange

An attractive beefsteak orange tomato. Low acid, sweeter tomato. Fruit are 0.5 to 1 lb. Indeterminate, matures in 75 days.

Tip: When planting your tomato plants you can plant them deeper than they come in the pot, all the way up to the top few leaves. Tomatoes can develop roots all along the stem and this makes for a stronger plant.


A very long pale green Italian summer squash. Mild flavour, great for stir-fry, steaming or pickling. Matures in 80 days.

Eggplant

Eggplants do well in containers. Should be fertilized every watering and every 2 weeks, leach out the media with just water. In the garden fertilize after 6 weeks and again when their is fruit.

Crystal Apple

Small fruit at 8 cm diameter that has a mild flavour. Likes regular moisture. Does will in containers. Matures in 75 days.

Kiwano

Green-yellow skin turn bright orange when it is ready for harvest. Has a mild flavour that is sweet-sour, and banana-lime like. It goes well with yogurt. Matures in 85 days.

Tamarillo Dwarf

Fruit is a deep gold orange when ripe. Fruit is sweet and slight taste like pineapple. Eat as is or in a smoothie. Harvest in 600 days. Needs to come inside for the winter. Grows to 3 m high and grows fast. Parts of the plant are poisonous if ingested.

Ground Cherry

Fruit is sweet and ripe when it falls to the ground. The husks are not edible. Used is sauces, jams and pies. Require similar conditions to tomatoes and peppers. Matures in 70 days.

A vine that produces small fruit that has a mild, sweet flavour. They can be as big as a tennis ball. Keep soil moist and warm. Matures in 70 days. Keep fruit picked for better production.

Young leaves are lemon scented and nice in teas. Uses: culinary, medicinal, aromatic, beverages.





Borage

An annual that has beautiful edible flowers. Chop up young leaves and add to salads and drinks. Uses: culinary, medicinal, beverages.

A perennial that most cats get a short high off of. It can be added to salads, soups, sauces and savory dishes for flavouring. Uses: cats, culinary, medicinal.



Bergamot Wild

A perennial, that pollinators like. Makes a pleasant tea and a great choice for potpourri. Uses: culinary, medicinal, aromatic, beverages.





Calendula

Plants are 30 cm high and can be grown in containers or in the garden. Sprinkle tangy petals in salads or use to decorate cakes. Petals are also used in soap making. They will reseed themselves, so remove spent flowers. This also encourages new flowers.

Chervil

Us a member of the parsley family and is used in French cuisine. It has a mild licorice or anise flavour and goes well with eggs, in soups and salads and with fish and chicken. Uses: culinary, medicinal.



Chamomile German

An annual that self-seeds itself. Used in tea, and salads. Uses: medicinal, beverages, aromatic, cosmetic.





Garlic Chives

Perennial with large white globe flowers. Has a chive and garlic taste. Used in salads and eggs. Height: 30 to 75 cm. Uses: culinary, medicinal.

Used to improve poor soil. Has the potential to self seed. Flowers are edible and used medicinally. Uses: medicinal, beverage.



Chives

A perennial that adds a slight onion flavour to salads, eggs and other dishes. Flowers can be used too and add a lovely flavour and colour to salads and as a garnish. Uses: culinary, medicinal.

Cilantro

Used in Asian and Latin American cuisine. Cilantro will bolt and go to seed in warm temperatures. To have a constant supply, seed or replant every 2 to 3 weeks.

Comfrey

A perennial that grows to 5 feet tall. The roots are used medicinally. It will spread, so keep it confined and don't till the area. Also do not allow it to seed.



Culantro / Mexican Coriander

A fantastic substitute for cilantro. Culantro does well in hot climates and does not bolt. It is an annual in the Okanagan. Cook lightly, dries well. Uses: culinary. medicinal.



Dill

Excellent used fresh as dillweed or allowed to go to seed for dill pickles. Uses: culinary, medicinal, beverages.

Echinacea purpurea

A perennial that is an ornamental and has many medicinal properties. Grows to 60 to 125 cm high.

A short busy daisy like perennial. Sell seeds. As many medicinal properties and uses.

Lemon Balm

A perennial that is used in tea, tincture and salads. Can spread. Flowers will attract bees. Uses: culinary, medicinal, beverages, aromatic.

Lemon Verbena

A tender perennial. Can be overwintered inside, but may lose it's leaves. Very strong lemon flavour. Fantastic in tea, cold drinks, salad dressing. Uses: culinary, medicinal, beverages, aromatic.

Perennial, easy to grow and is 2 m high. Leaves are used in soups and gravy. The Dutch call it 'maggiplant'. Uses: culinary, medicinal, beverages, aromatic.

An annual in the Okanagan that grows well in containers. Lemon scented grass. Used in soups, teas, smoothies, sauces and stir fries. In Thai and Vietnamese dishes. Use in kitchen muslin bags and remove when done. Uses: culinary, medicinal, beverages, aromatic.

Marjoram

Leaves add a strong, spicy flavour to dishes. It is similar in flavour to oregano, but milder. It is full of nutrients. Uses: culinary, medicinal, beverages, aromatic. Will not survive Okanagan winters.

A perennial and the tallest mint. Has an apple mint flavour and can be used in applemint jelly, potato dishes, couscous and tea. Uses: culinary, medicinal, beverage, aromatic.

A perennial and used to make mojito cocktails. Has a milder flavour that isn't as sweet. Also makes a nice cold tea. Uses: culinary, medicinal, beverages.

An annual. The leaves are cinnamon-scented and used in Japanese cooking to flavour raw fish, bean curd, pickles and tempura. Loves the hot sun. Uses: culinary, medicinal, beverages.
